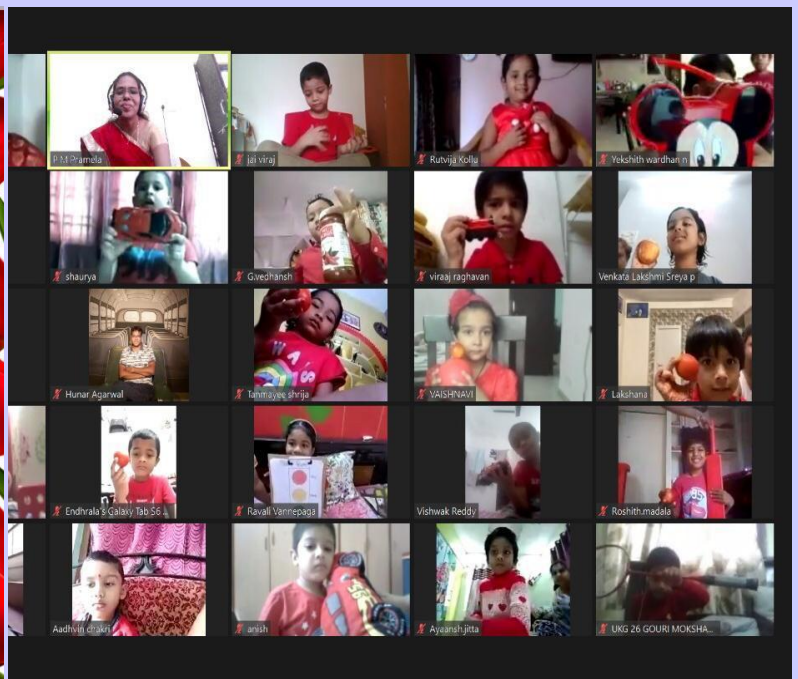




(iv) Red Colour Day:

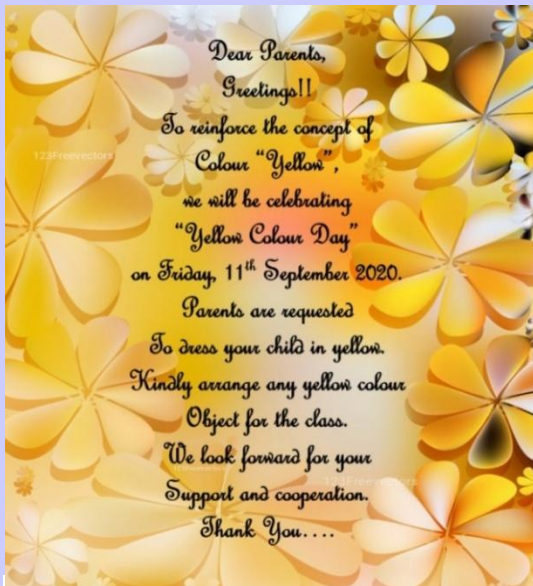

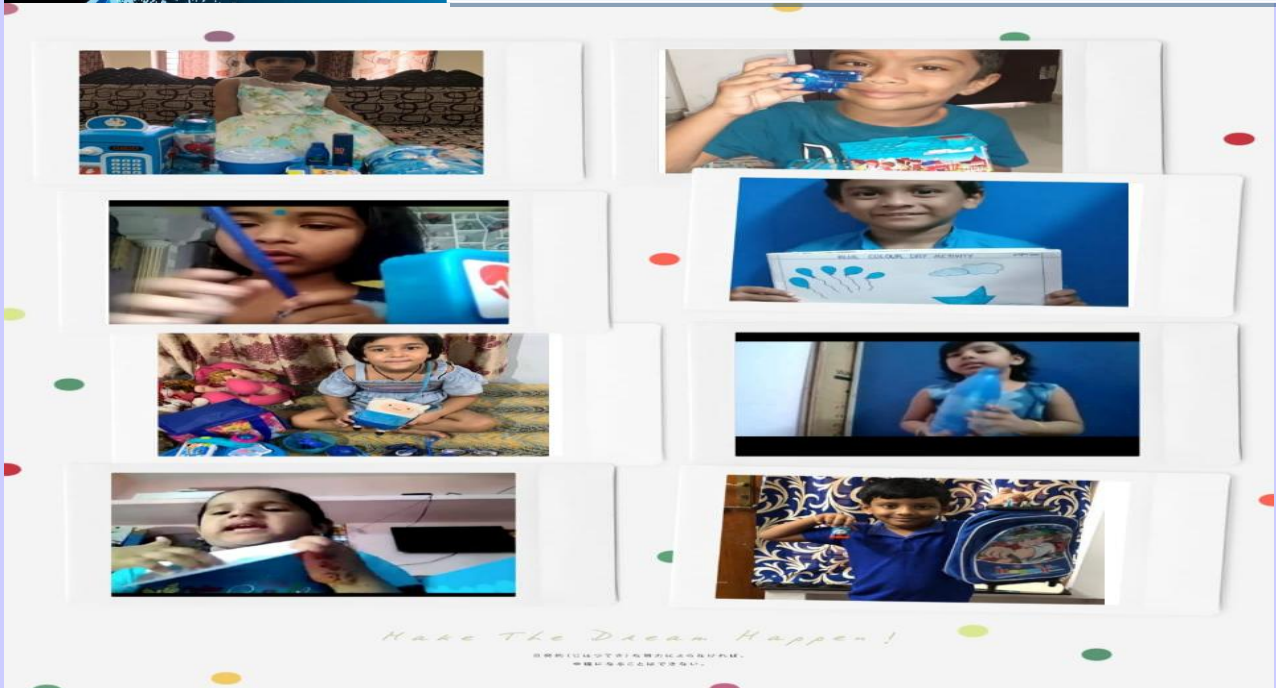


(viii) Blue Colour Day:

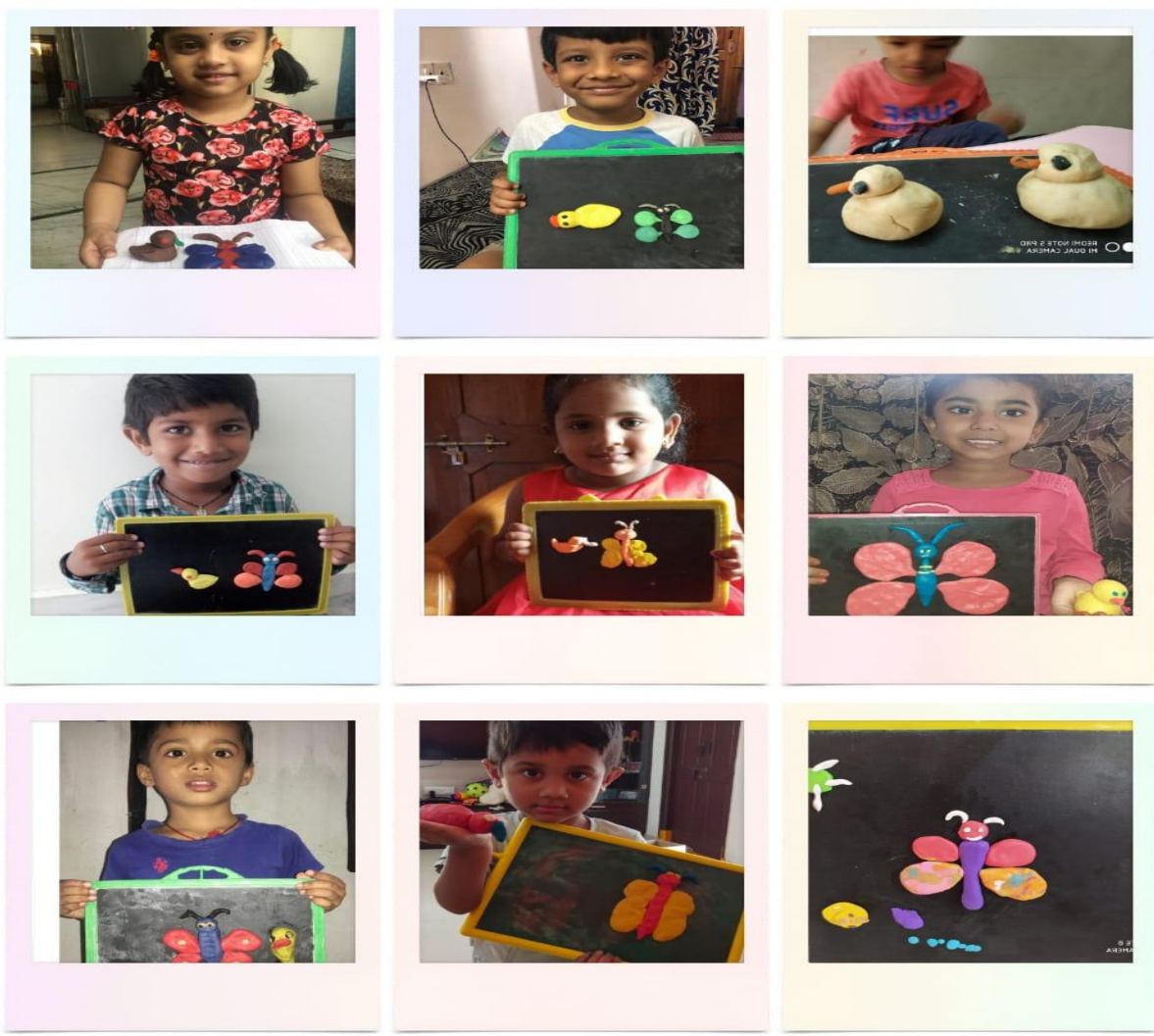


(ix) Clay Moulding Activity:

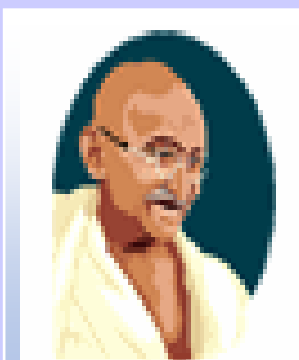

(x) **Gandhi Jayanti Celebration:**

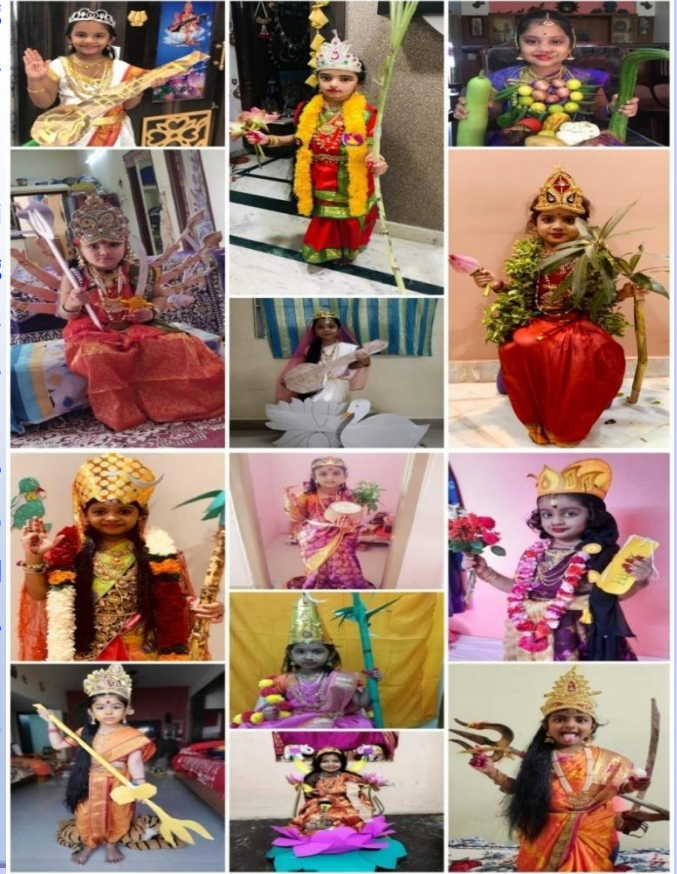

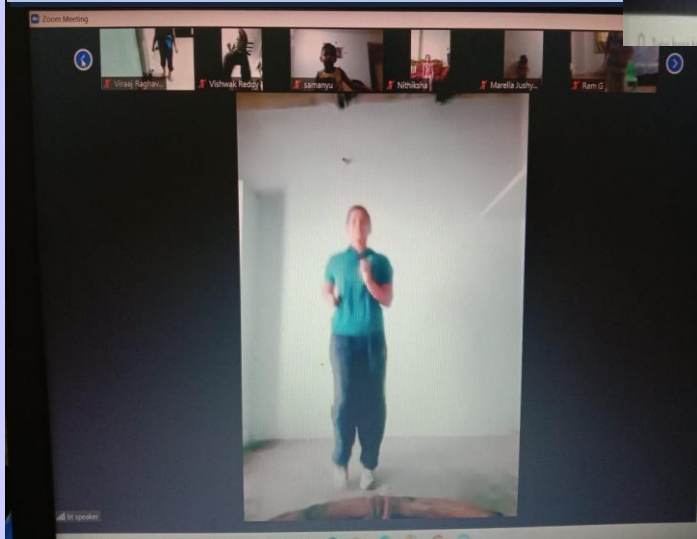
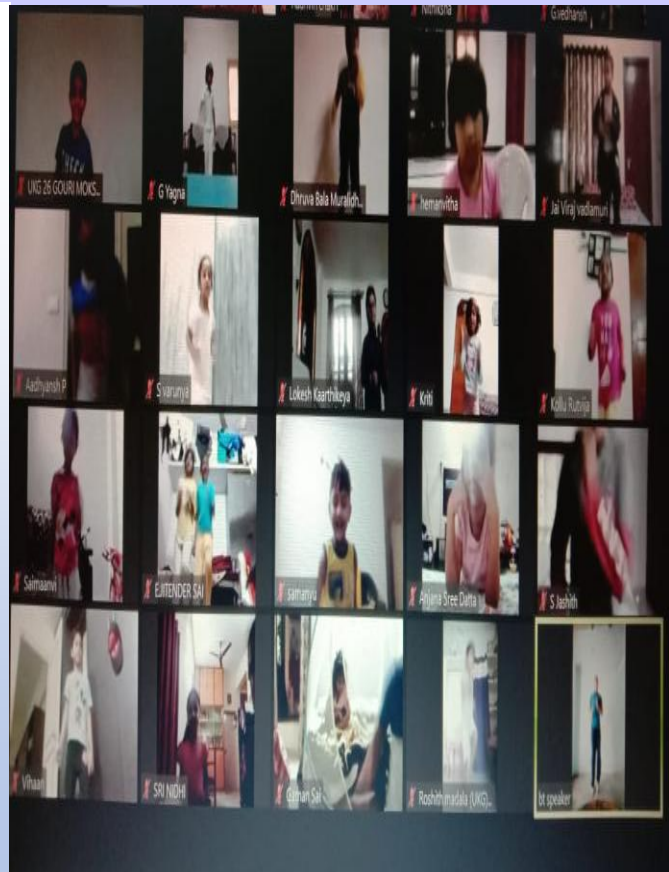
On this day teacher taught kids to do rat, fish and puppy and cat using colourful papers. Kids learnt paper folding and tried making these paper origami with great enthusiasm.

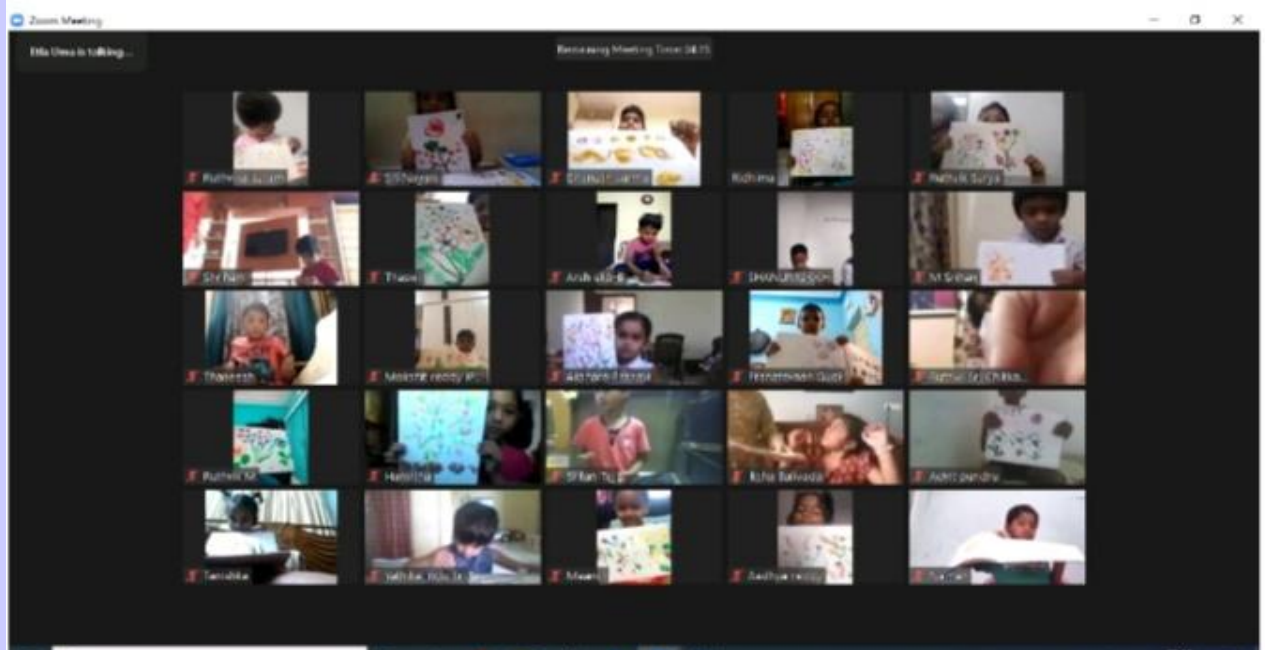
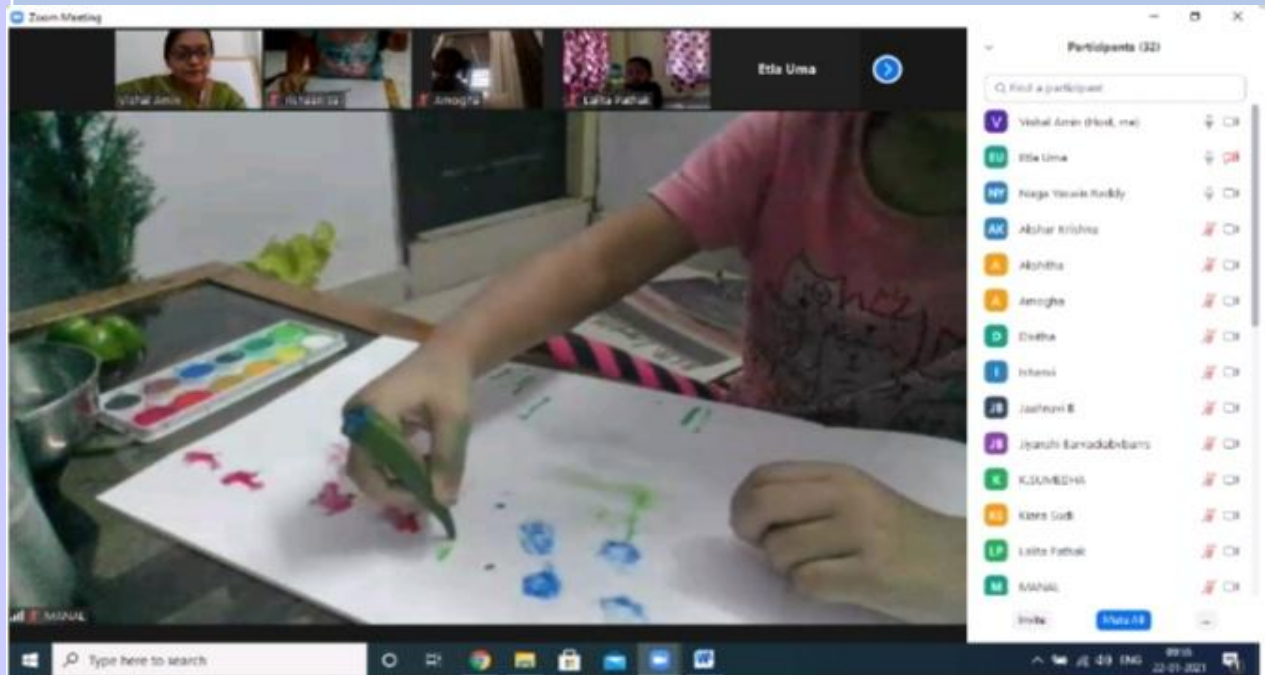
