TRUTH, which is accord between mind, word and deed;


DEDICATION which offers all movements of life as an offering to God;

On this day teacher taught kids to do rat, fish and puppy and cat using colourful papers. Kids learnt paper folding and tried making these paper origami with great enthusiasm.





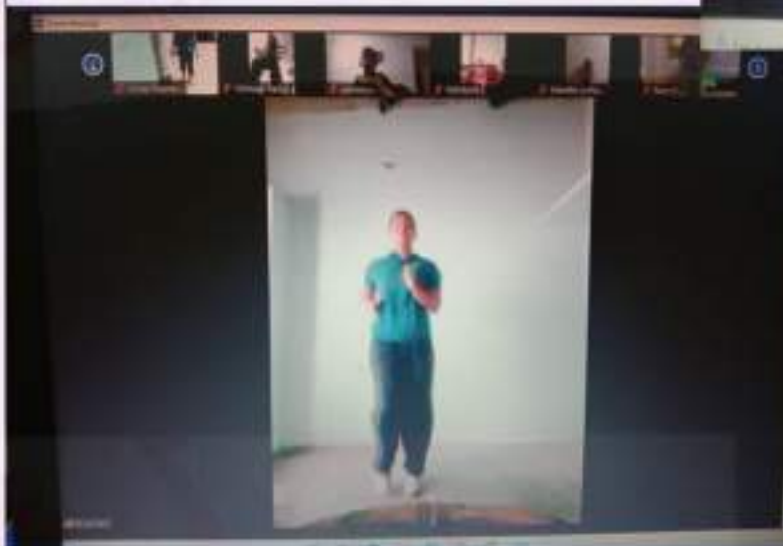
# Fit India Programme

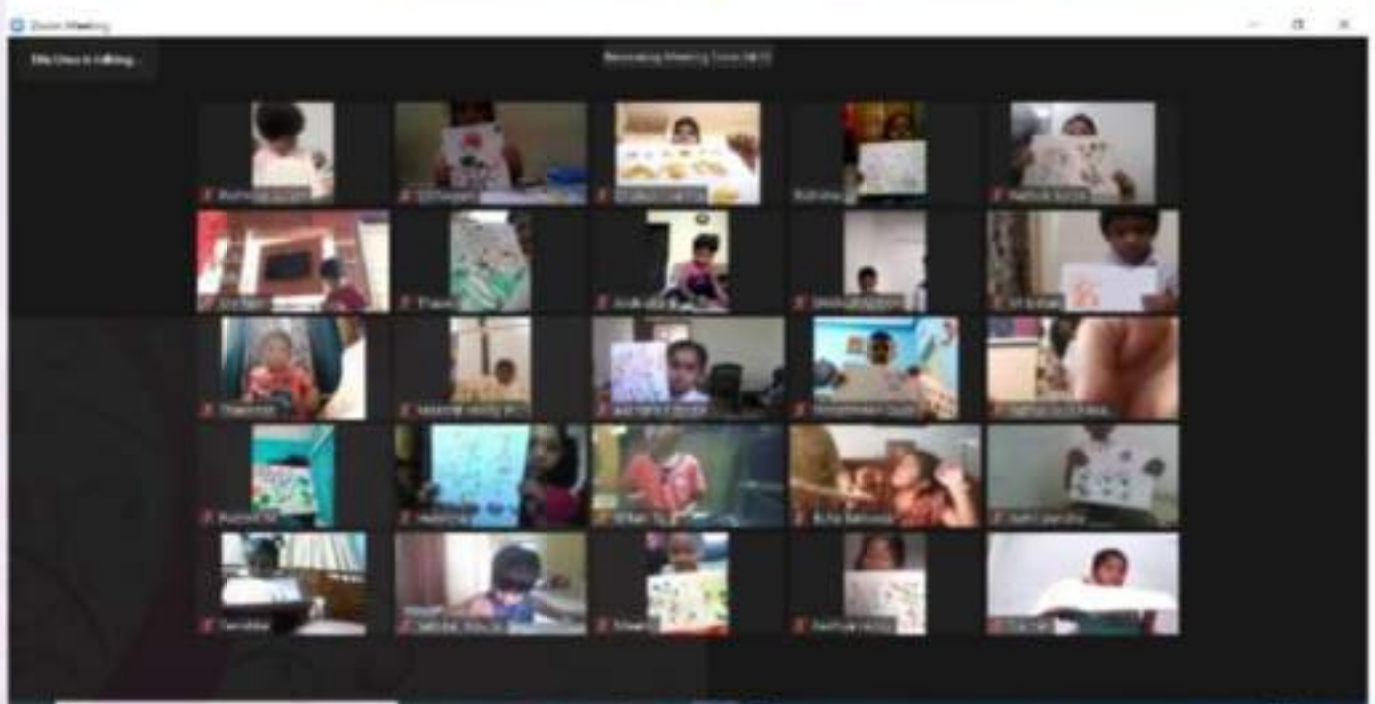
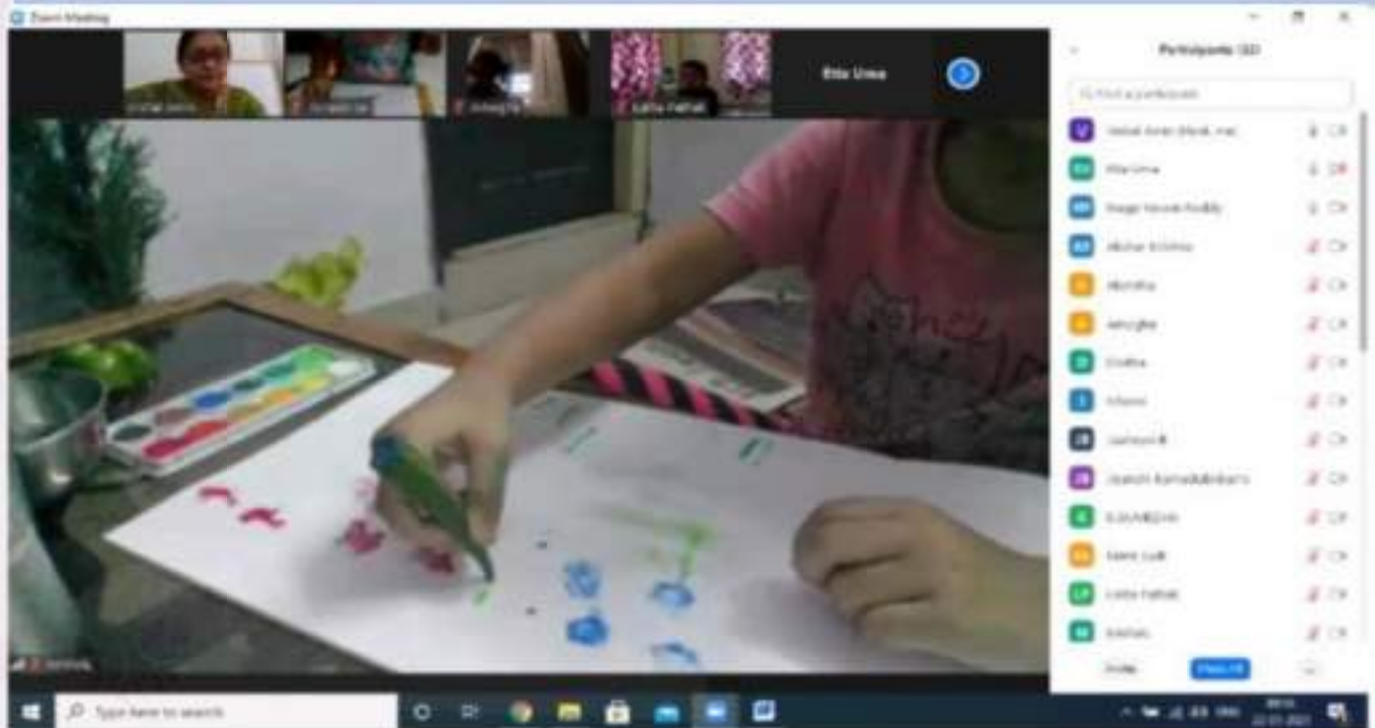






## Vegetable Printing Activity

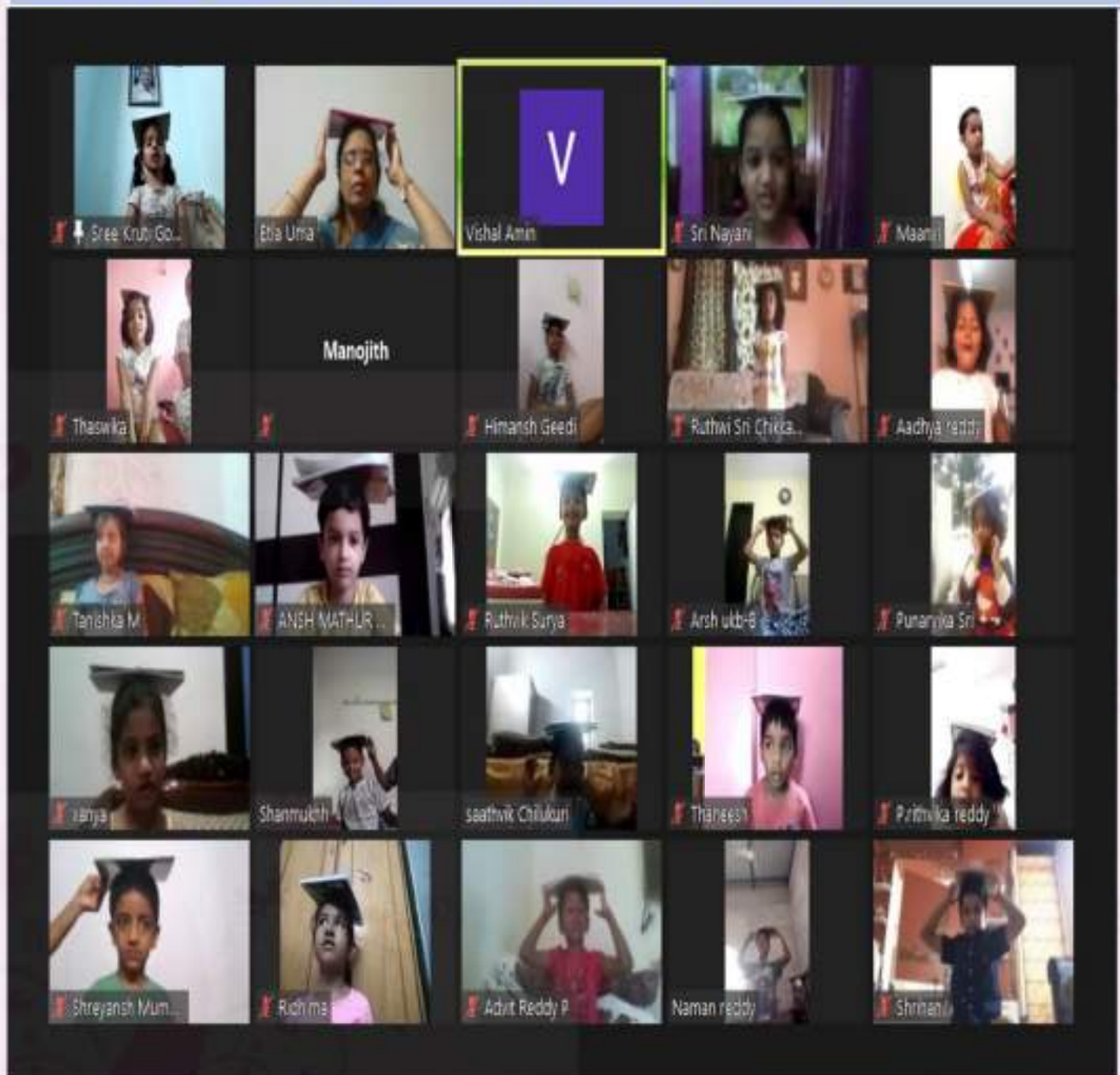

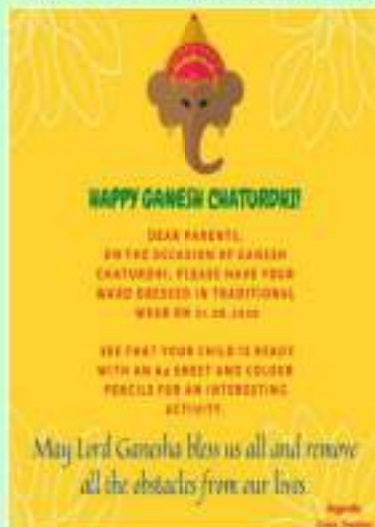

### Ganga Utsav

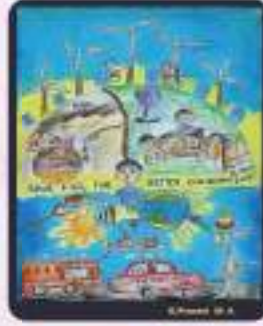
