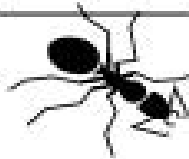

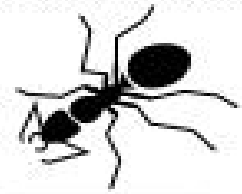
The ants dragged me up the stairs and along a corridor. We came to a door, where another ant was standing guard.

"Is this Troy Cooper?" asked the guard.

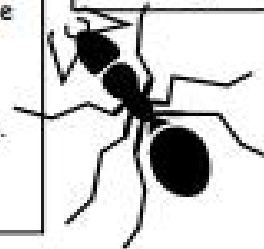
"Yes, this is the accused," replied one of my captors.
