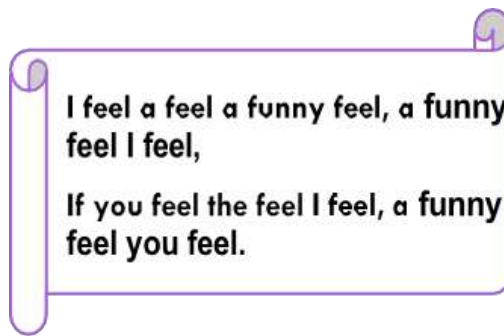
3. **Word chain:** This assignment should be done on an A4 sheet.
