Subject -Science

I. Take 20-30 seeds each of boiled, roasted, and normal green gram (moong). You may also use other seeds such as chickpea (chana) and black gram (urad dal). Wash them thoroughly and place them in separate bowls lined with moist cotton cloth. Cover the seeds with the cloth. Leave the bowls undisturbed. Do not refrigerate. Make sure the cloth remains moist by sprinkling water. Observe the seeds once a day for any changes. Record your observations in a table, as shown below.
