Activity:

India's culture is deeply influenced by local, regional, and indigenous traditions (e.g., reverence for nature in the Toda tribe or Northeast India), shaping a diverse and sensitive cultural fabric. Keeping this in view, do the following activities.

Tribal Culture Dossier: Research and list 2-3 local tribal groups (e.g., Bhils, Gonds, Santhals) to document their art, belief systems, and traditional practices.(Use A4 size sheets).

Key Indian Tribal Art Forms

Warli Painting:

Originating from Maharashtra, these paintings use basic geometric shapes—circles, triangles, and squares—to depict social life on dark, earthy backgrounds.

Gond Art:

Practiced by the Gond community, these are known for vibrant colors, intricate lines, and dot-based patterns representing nature and mythology.

Pithora Painting:

A ritualistic art form from Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh, often featuring horses to represent deities and community life.

Saura Art:

Ritualistic wall paintings (ikons) from Odisha featuring elongated human figures and themes like the tree of life, often painted on red-earth walls.

Sohrai Painting:

Mural art from Jharkhand, traditionally created by women using natural pigments to celebrate the harvest.
