Sometimes, a few simple words can make someone feel happy, loved, or understood.

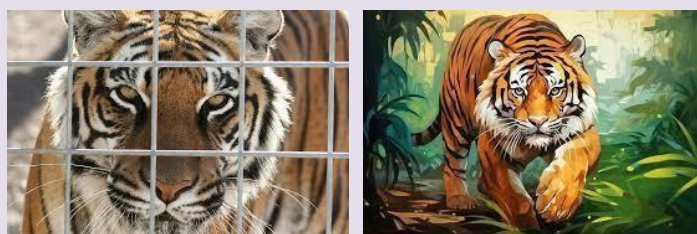
Think about a moment when you helped someone, shared a happy thought or learned something new.

Red lentils (masoor) → Another state

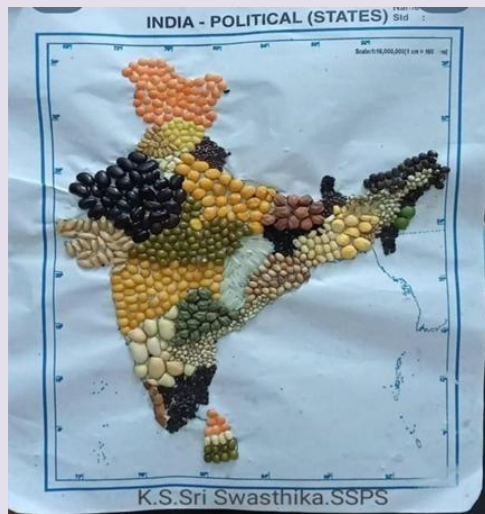
Chickpeas (chana) → Another state
